My values are evident and documented as I've served Alaskans over the past 9 years, Chairing various committees (most recently House Education) and one of the most significant Commissions (CACFA). ***I am seeking to continue representing District 10 (NW Wasilla and the Communities in the Susitna River drainage). I humbly request your vote.***

I enthusiastically promote the marvelous values in our Alaska Constitution, the ones I have sworn to defend and uphold, from page 1, line 1; "...all persons have a natural right to life, liberty, the pursuit of happiness, and the enjoyment of the rewards of their own industry; that all persons are equal... All government originates with the people, is founded upon their will only, and is instituted solely for the good of the people." These lines validate my positions on Divine providence, family, free market, jobs, justice, rule of law, limited government, and the development of natural resources for the maximum benefit of Alaskans.

One of the most critical issues of this election cycle is the determination of whether "maximum benefit" of Alaskans lies in ownership of personal property (the PFD) or in expanded benevolent government spending - using money earned from investment of the restricted Permanent Fund (PF). Per capita, Alaska already outspends any other State using money from direct natural resources development; and, in my opinion, must not expand by dipping into money that would otherwise become PFD money.
