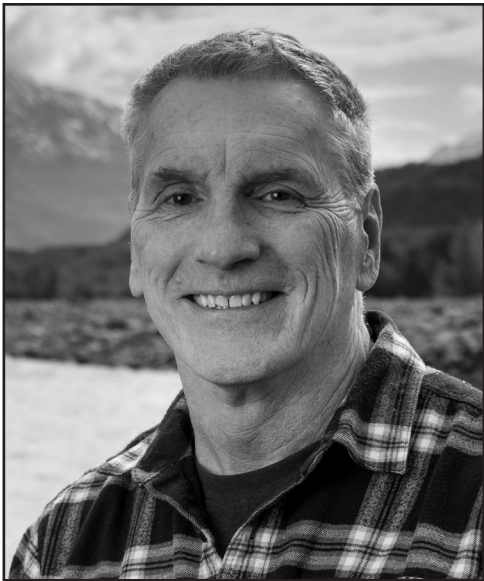

To retain teachers who are otherwise avoiding or fleeing our state, it is imperative not only to improve pay and working conditions like class sizes but finally restore a viable pension system.
