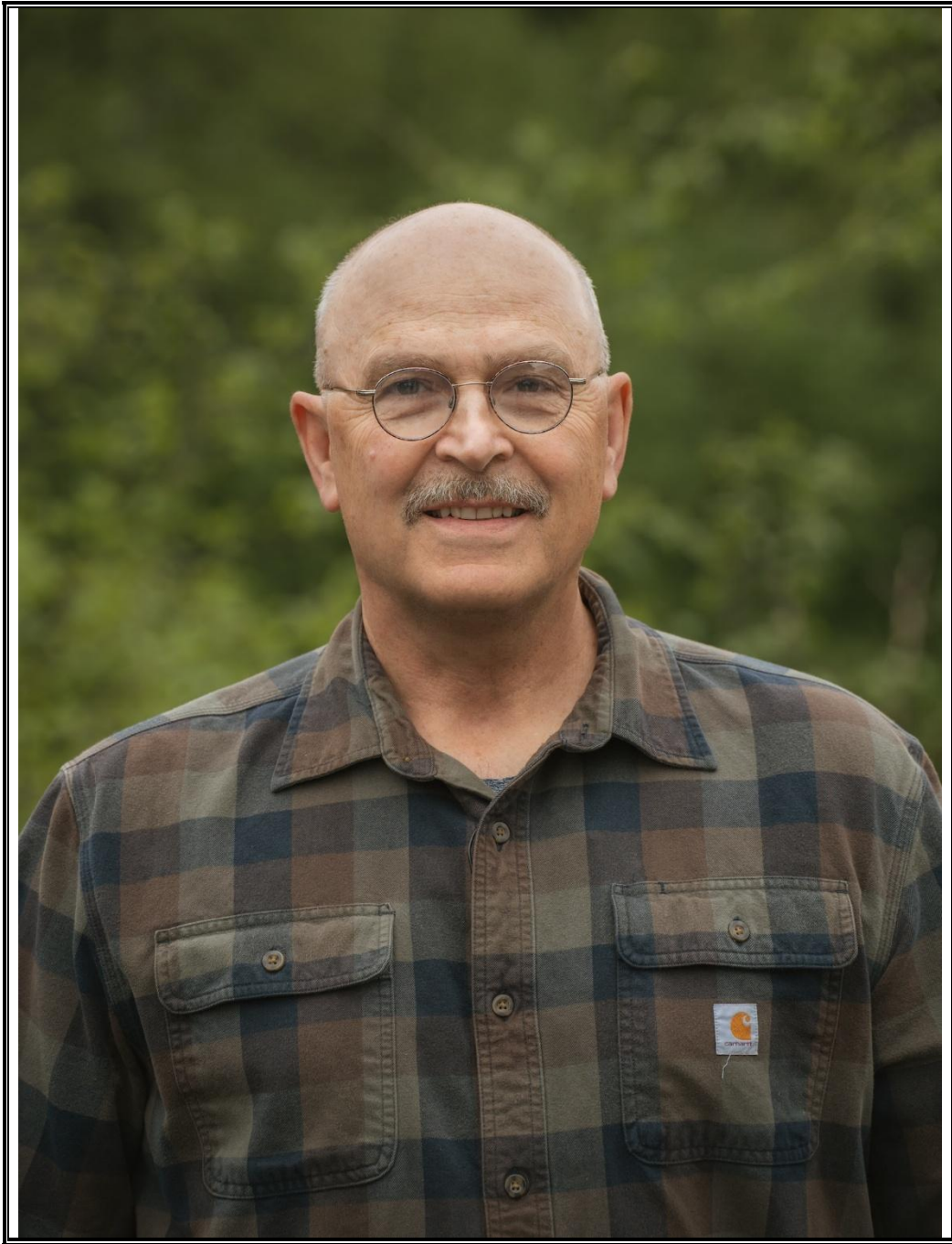
Sustainable Fisheries
