I provided 25 years of service to the US Army, and this Nation, with multiple combat tours between conventional and special operations. I returned home to Alaska to serve as a policy advisor for both a US Senator and the Governor of Alaska. I have dedicated my life to service to others, and enjoy showing up to do the work, solving complex problems and helping people.

Position Statement

My campaign will focus on five priorities that directly affect Eagle River families.

First, I will stand with veterans, military families, and JBER by removing employment and licensing barriers, improving access to services, supporting veteran-owned businesses, and protecting the infrastructure and policies needed to keep Alaska a strong military state.

Second, I will fight to make Alaska more affordable by advancing permitting reform that expedites responsible resource development, creates jobs, and lowers the cost of housing, energy, healthcare, groceries, and government. I will also oppose policies that burden small businesses already struggling to make ends meet, because when local businesses face higher costs, those costs are passed on to every family.

Third, I will expand childcare through targeted tax credits for employers and providers that create new spaces, help employees cover costs, and serve families working nontraditional hours.

Fourth, I will put parents and students first by protecting parental involvement, school choice, charter schools, neighborhood schools, homeschooling, and career and technical education. Education decisions should be made with families, not imposed on them.

Finally, I will prioritize public safety by supporting law enforcement, strengthening prosecution, targeting fentanyl traffickers and violent repeat offenders, and putting victims first. I will also fight to establish a Level II trauma center in Eagle River by reforming the Certificate of Need process and securing a capital appropriation to help construct the facility. Eagle River families deserve timely access to lifesaving emergency care within their own community.
