Position Statement

My name is Adam Crum. I am running for Governor of Alaska.

I grew up in a two-bedroom dry cabin in Anchor Point with seven people in my family. We hauled our own water and worked hard. That upbringing shaped everything I believe about Alaska and about what good government owes the people it serves.

I went to school out of state and came back because Alaska is worth fighting for. But too many Alaskans are leaving. In 13 years, we have lost more than 57,000 people. That is not a trend. That is a crisis.

I have spent my career building things. I co-owned Northern Industrial Training, Alaska's largest post-secondary training provider. I served as Commissioner of Health and Social Services, managing 3,500 employees and a \$3.5 billion budget. I served as Commissioner of Revenue, managing the Permanent Fund and pushing back on anti-Arctic investment policies from out-of-state banks. I won.

As Governor, I will develop Alaska's resources, build the gas line, cut waste in government, and make this state affordable again. I want my daughters, Ellie and Lucy, to have a future here. I want every Alaska family to have that same choice.
