STATEMENT:

I'm Carrie Harris. I've been an Alaskan since 1999, living in Anchorage and Juneau before moving to Homer in 2014 and Anchor Point in 2015. I'm running because Alaskans deserve true representation. Too many people talk about the state as if it's something separate from us, but we are the state. The government we set up should reflect the will of the people. When 74% of Alaskans say they want trawl gear removed from our waters and nothing happens, that's not just a policy disagreement. That's a system consciously putting itself above the people, and if allowed to continue, it will never represent us. My priorities are straightforward: remove trawl gear from state waters, protect the PFD by putting the formula into the Constitution, cut wasteful spending, and move the capital to the road system. Crucially, I will fiercely defend Alaskans' fundamental right to privacy. Your personal data, movements, and private information belong to you, not the government. I will fight to ban warrantless biometric surveillance, halt intrusive data collection, and block continuous digital tracking of law-abiding citizens. I'm running to represent the people of my Senate district and the State of Alaska. I'm running so the people remember exactly who the government works for.
