I believe good government is measured by honesty, accountability, and careful stewardship of public resources. Decisions should be based on facts, sound analysis, and respect for differing viewpoints.

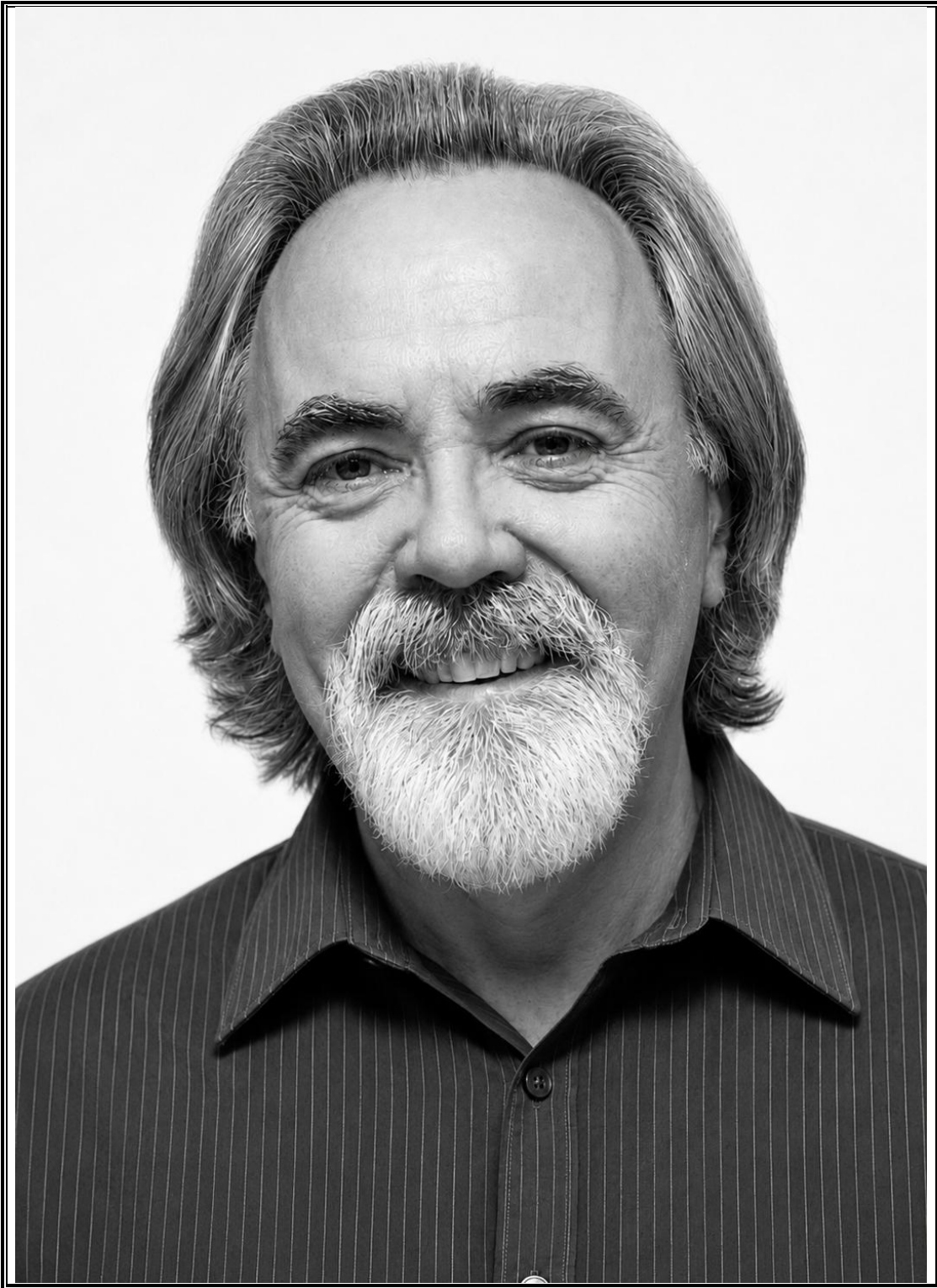
