Position Statement

I believe we must protect LGBTQ people and trans youth, abortion rights and access, environmental protections, multi-racial democracy, election rights and access, a humane and timely immigration system, and the U.S. Constitution.

I believe in expanding Medicaid, Medicare, Veterans Affairs, Indian Health Services with the goal of universal health care. In order to create the infrastructure for these services, we need to expand financial aid opportunities to higher education, with the goal of universal higher education, for colleges, universities and trade schools. We must stop sending weapons to foreign countries who face allegations of genocide, and use that funding to invest in schools and healthcare.

We need a congress that will act to serve our citizens, not dark money or corporate influence. We must install term limits on members of congress, ban insider trading, limit political contributions and create a system of oversight for the Supreme Court.

In order to achieve these goals, we must first address the illegal wars, weaponization of Immigration and Customs Enforcement and Border Patrol who has killed US citizens and not yet been brought to justice, the failure to release the Epstein files and prosecute perpetrators.

I support using all methods available to make the American government work for it's citizens again, including impeachment.
