### Position Statement

As Chair of the House Health & Social Services Committee, I have worked to defend SNAP and Medicaid from government bureaucracy. In this past term, I led on three laws to help Alaskans get timely, quality medical treatment: expanding primary care at the pharmacy, improving the state's response to heart attacks and strokes, and modernizing medical records. I also advocated for medical debt relief, public transit, welcoming New Alaskans (including immigrants and refugees), behavioral health services, wage transparency, and addressing youth homelessness.

So long as I feel the absence of friends who have left the state and the cynicism of neighbors towards their home, I will step up to champion a better Alaska. I know there's a future here if we have a functioning government that listens to communities, protects civil liberties, and supports opportunities for Alaskans to succeed.

My priorities:

- Protect the Permanent Fund and PFD by passing new revenues
- Address high costs of child care, housing, energy, and health care
- Fully fund schools from Pre-K to UAA and trades
- Improve government services and reform pensions for state employees
- Strengthen neighborhoods through safe streets and parks
- Support local business and grow Alaska's workforce
- Invest in renewables and preserve our lands and waters

I would be honored to continue serving the area that raised me and fight for the needs of Airport Heights, Mountain View, and Russian Jack as your state representative.
