Glenn “Mike” Prax was born in Sleepy Eye, Minnesota in 1956, and moved to Alaska with his family in 1969. He lives in the Badger area of the Fairbanks North Star Borough and graduated from Lathrop High School in 1974. A working Alaskan, Mike worked in his family's Star of the North Bakery, spent years as an operations and maintenance technician with Alyeska Pipeline Service Company, owned and managed Prospector Outfitters, and worked as an insurance producer at Dick Randolph State Farm Insurance.

His public service spans decades. He was a Republican Party District Chair in the 1980s and represented Fairbanks on the Borough Assembly from 1997 to 2001. In 2020, Governor Mike Dunleavy appointed Mike to the Alaska House to fill the North Pole seat vacated by Rep. Tammie Wilson. Voters have returned him every election since. He remains one of the House's most senior members.

Position Statement

Serving the people of House District 33 has been the honor of my lifetime. I'm a working Alaskan, not a career politician — I've worked the pipeline, run a small business, and raised my family right here in the Interior. I bring that same practical, hands-on approach to the Legislature every day.

Since my appointment in 2020, I've earned the trust of my colleagues and become one of the most senior members of the Alaska House — the 12th most senior of our 40 members.
