We've secured the largest federal investment in Alaska's healthcare system at \$1.4 billion to lower costs.

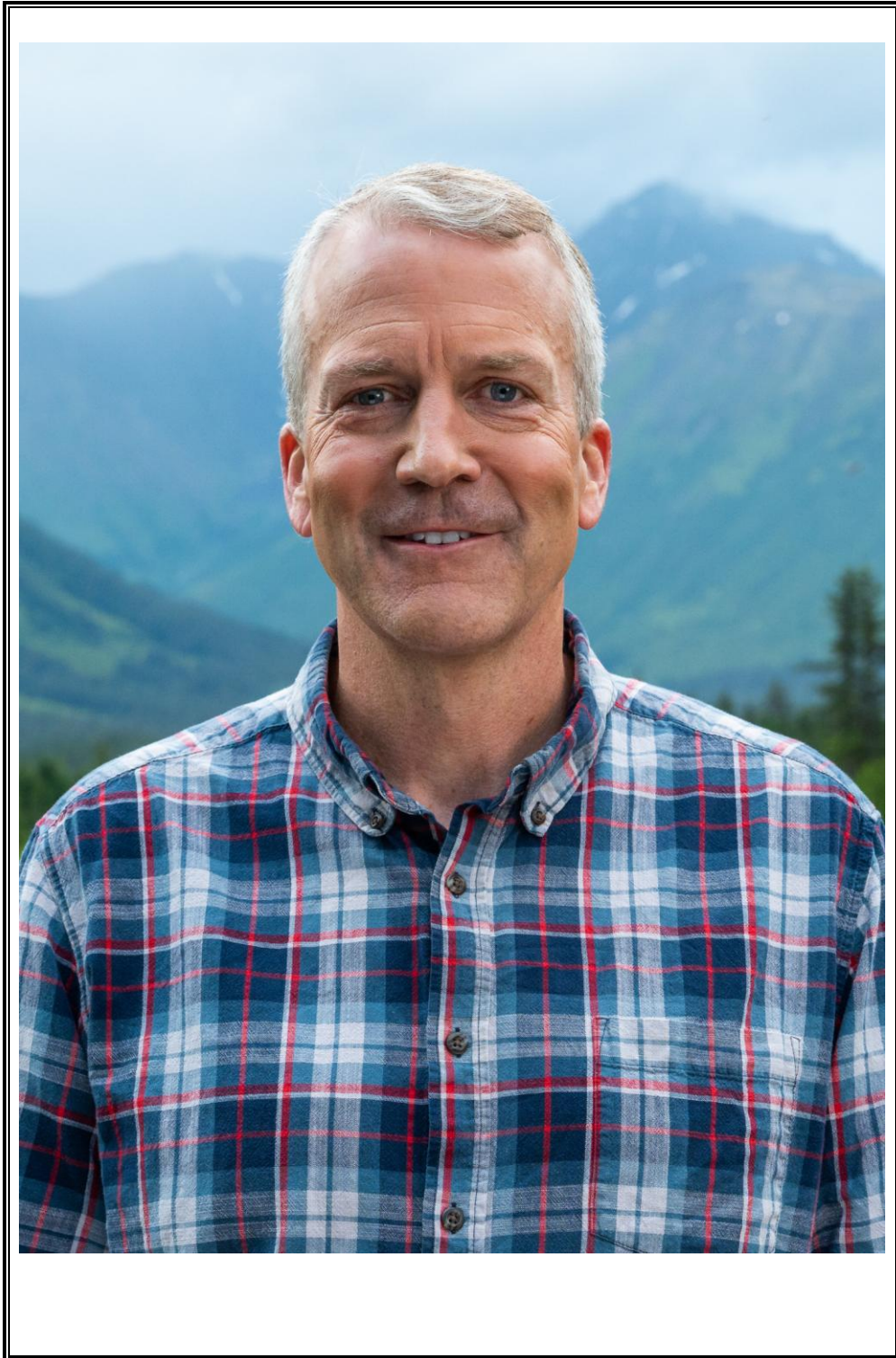
